Lot 40 - Upper right diagonal half of 12c black used as 6c (36a), on cover with 1851 1c, 3c, to make up 10 cent rate from New York to St. Johns New Brunswick; the stamps lightly cancelled in black "New York Nov. 18, (1852)", the cancellation covering the bisect; the stamps are slightly creased by a fold in the letter, but the cover very fine and probably unique as this bisect is usually found on covers from San Francisco.
