Perf 99 R 2 - Ward wrote Krug in Nov. 1939
Re Brown sale copy:

"I enclose herewith the 1861 10¢ reissue from the Brown sale in perfection condition, at \$65. A second enclosure is the 1857 1¢ type III 99R2, with light blue cancellation. This is the finer of the three copies known and was sold to Brown by Kelleher at \$600. It sort of seems ridiculous to me that the perforated 99R2 should list at \$500 when three copies are known, whereas the imperforate of which possibly 25 or 30 copies are known lists at \$600. I quote you a special price of \$300 on this item but if you do not take it and it goes into my stock, I want \$350 for it.
