5¢ 1857 - Type I - Indian Red - E.C.Krug wrote
Aug. 1, 1943:

"About the 5¢ 1857 Type I Indian Red. I have a single which I bought from a sale of Theodore Reinhardt of Chicago and which I had sent to you first for approval. I doubt if you recall it. Cost me \$36.

Also I have lot #2623 from the first Knapp sale of June 1940 for which I paid \$60 and being a strip of three vertical on cover to France.

You said it was the real Indian Red in a letter to me then. IT MUST BE. I always said this cover was a steal and worth many times more.

Maybe I am wrong.

It might not be amiss to try and get a superb used copy or two as an investment. What do you

think?"
